

POSITION: GRAMMAR SCHOOL FACULTY (One Position Teaching Select Classes Across Grades 5 & 6)

Delaware Valley Classical School (DVCS) is a classical Christian educational community of 178 students and 32 faculty and staff located in New Castle, Delaware. The school has roots dating back 30 years. At DVCS, we offer a robust K-12 education within the context of a partnership between parents and the school, with a view toward perpetuating the values of excellence, wisdom, joy and gratitude in our community. We seek excellence in academics inspired by a challenging classical curriculum with a biblical world-view and a disciplined atmosphere that focuses on high standards of behavior and Christian character.

DVCS is seeking a dynamic addition to our grammar school program for the 24-25 academic year for grades 5 & 6. At DVCS, grades 5 & 6 operate in a structure that involves collaboration among two primary teachers. This role will serve as the grade 5 homeroom teacher. In addition, the teacher will teach the following subjects: 5 History, 5 Literature/Reading, 5 Bible, 5 U.S. Geography, 5 Presentations, 5 & 6 Mathematics, 6 History, and 6 Geography.
